

Men's Champions League 2020-2021 Format and Rules

HKLA Encourages established teams with a committed pool of players to register a team. We ask that teams that rely heavily on "additional players" from division 2 teams consider combining with other teams to avoid forfeits.

Registration

Registration will open at 10:00am on Saturday December 5th, 2020. Registration is first come, first serve. 12 Teams will participate in the 2020-2021 Men's Champions League.

*NO registration fee will be charged unless the fields and the game schedule have been confirmed.

- 1. Captains/managers register team on website with team name and pay a team fee of 7,000HKD
- 2. Players can register under a team name
 - o Players are approved by captains first and then added to the team
- 3. Registration will remain open until the beginning of playoffs.
- 4. There is no limit to the number of players that can be registered for any team, however only 23 players may be dressed/active at any one game.
- 5. Teams will be divided into two divisions based on previous results in the Champions League seasons, strength of roster, number of registered players.

Schedule and Format

- Both divisions will play from January to May.
- Games will be played at Po Tsui, KGV, Tsang Tai Uk, Po Kong Village etc.
- Following the completion of team registration, HKLA will draft and distribute as complete of a schedule is possible for the season. Captains will have an opportunity to request changes to the schedule.
- Teams that are unable to field at least 9 players will forfeit the game.
- Teams that forfeit a scheduled, regular season game, will pay a fee of 550HKD.

Player Sharing and Playoff Eligibility

- Players not registered for a team will not be able to play in the Men's Champions League.
- Division 1 and division 2 teams are permitted to field up to 5 additional players per regular season game. These additional players must be individuals who are registered for a division 2 Men's Champions League team.
- If teams choose to utilize additional players during playoffs or placement games, they must register a list of no more than 5 players prior to the start of post-season play.
- Division 1 players are not permitted to act as additional players.
- Exceptions will be made for HKU students selected to play for team HKU.

GAME RULES:

Men's games: World Lacrosse 2019-2020 Rules of Men's Field Lacrosse (Except for rule changes stated below)

Duration:

Men- 4 quarters of 15 minutes running time, stop last 2 minutes of 4th quarter.

Breaks:

Halftime will be a 4-minute intermission and quarter breaks for men will be 2 minutes.

Timeouts:

Teams are allowed One Timeout (90 seconds) per half.

Overtime (OT):

No OT will occur for Round Robin Games. For Playoff Games, the OT format will be a 4-minute OT period after a 1-minute break. If it is still a draw, then a 4-minute Sudden Death OT will take place, repeating until a goal.

Warmup:

Warmups will need to occur off the field if there is no available time prior to the start of the game.

Weather Cancellation Arrangement:

A game shall be cancelled and rescheduled when any of the following weather hazard warnings is hoisted within 3 hours before the match. Final decision will be discussed with the captains.

- Red/Black rainstorm warning
- Thunderstorm warning
- Typhoon signal no. 3 or above

The team representatives will be informed by HKLA about the game rescheduling accordingly.
